Make a paper noisemaker to celebrate with.

### You will need:

- a piece of notebook or copier paper
- \* crayons or markers
- ∗ ruler
- \* scissors

## How to:

- 1. Cut a piece of paper 7" or 8" square.
- Color it or write "Happy New Year & Happy New You" on it.
- 3. Fold paper almost in half. The bottom edge should be <sup>1</sup>/2" from the top. Crease the fold well.
- 4. Fold in half side-to-side with the shorter flap inside. Crease well.
- 5. Hold the paper tightly between thumb and index finger at open corner where there are only 2 thicknesses.
- 6. Quickly flick your arm and wrist downward. The inside paper will pop out and make a loud snap.
