Dear friends,

How many of you heard (all too often!) when you were raising your kids—"I'm bored!" Either you came up with some creative, incredible, entertaining afternoon of activities for your bored children, or, more likely, you said, "OK. So go outside and play!"

Tolstoy defined boredom as "a desire for desires." Psychoanalyst Adam Phillips called it "that state of suspended animation in which things are started and nothing begins, the mood of diffuse restlessness which contains that most absurd and paradoxical wish, the wish for a desire." Those are rather esoteric definitions of a condition that really just gives us the feeling that something is missing, but we can't quite say what.

Child psychologists agree that boredom is actually good for child development. Boredom can actually help them develop skills, creativity and self-esteem. A child who can find a creative way out of boredom will grow into an adult who is self-assured and confident, a self-starter who is often very creative.

But do you ever find yourself bored with God, or bored with the church? Every Sunday, the same old thing—some songs, boring responsive readings, same old boring hymns, and then the sermon... boy, that can be a snooze-fest! It's easy to fall into a rut when it comes to attending worship, to having a close relationship with God. You want to sleep in on Sunday morning, you've already read the Bible, and besides, it's hard to understand.

#### Serving Christ-in the Homeless




The SHARE (Salinas Housing Advancement Resources Education) Center is open and meeting the needs of the homeless and Northminster will continue to minister to them by providing and serving
